4	Southern Ocean	about 22 million km ² (8.5 million sq mi)
5	Arctic Ocean	about 15.6 million km ² (6 million sq mi)

Areas from Wikipedia (Ocean, List of seas on Earth), checked against Wikidata; the borders of a sea are a matter of definition, so sources differ and we round. The ocean of each sea and its coastal countries are listed only where Wikipedia and Wikidata agree, so a list of countries may be shorter than the full coast.
