Nile: Sources disagree on its length: from about 6,650 to 7,088 km. Amazon River: Sources disagree on its length: from about 6,400 to 6,992 km. Yangtze: Sources disagree on its length: from about 6,300 to 6,418 km. Mississippi River: With its longest tributaries, the whole river system is about 6,275 km long. Ob: With its longest tributaries, the whole river system is about 5,410 km long. Amur: With its longest tributaries, the whole river system is about 4,444 km long. Elbe: With its longest tributaries, the whole river system is about 1,252 km long. Vistula: With its longest tributaries, the whole river system is about 1,213 km long.

Lengths from the Wikipedia list of river systems by length (or the river's article), checked against Wikidata. The length of a river depends on where you measure its source and its mouth, so every length is approximate and some are disputed.

Mouth, countries and cities are shown only where Wikipedia and Wikidata agree.
